**Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis (within 150 words)**

The study investigated the perception of fatherhood held by Jordanian expectant fathers. Three areas were investigated: how the expectant fathers defined fathering; how they prepared for fathering; and how they felt about fatherhood. Sixty fathers answered the open-ended questionnaire,

The majority of the expectant fathers (81.7%) expressed feelings of happiness. Nurturer/caregiver was identified by (31%) expectant fathers. Approximately 27% mentioned their intentions to share responsibilities with their wives. About 90% of the expectant fathers reflected the decision to rear their children differently than they had themselves been brought up. The expectant fathers of this study did not make many preparations. For a traditional culture, the traditional role still exists, where the priority is to provide financial and material needs for the family. This study was the first of its kind in Jordan. The finding of this study, although tentative, do provide a basis for recommendations for further research and for new responsibilities for nursing practice in Jordan
