### 19 Course Description:

This course is designed to give students an in depth understanding of the nature of emergency nursing and identify the role of the nurse in meeting different needs of emergency patients. The course provides students with the knowledge and skills that help them to provide efficient nursing care during emergency and disaster situations. The course will provide students the knowledge and skill to deliver basic and complex care to urgent, emergent, and critical patient population. Also nursing care for specific medical emergencies is considered.

The clinical part consists of two rotations; one in the clinical area and another in the lab. The practice in the clinical area introduces care for emergency clients, provides opportunities to enhance critical thinking, communication and systematic inquiry skills that are necessary to provide care to emergency clients and their families. The practice in the lab intends to introduce emergency nursing students to Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS).
